Our focus areas

ur work is streamlined to ensure the best use of our resources, and to optimise our impact. We focus on three strategic pillars of activity: social investment, capacity building, and policy design and advocacy. Alongside this, we continue to drive forward the King Khalid Award – the region's leading accolade for corporate sustainability, nonprofit excellence, and social innovation – and the prestigious Shaghaf Fellowship, which equips Saudi Arabia's emerging nonprofit leaders with the knowledge

and vision they need to deliver impact. Through these focus areas, we work to advance our mission, to emphasise partnerships, and to encourage inspiring action at all levels.

Social investment

We invest in people and organisations working to promote equality and create opportunity in Saudi Arabia. We provide funding to innovative nonprofit projects and organisations that support skills development, employment and job creation, and which benefit the wider community. We focus particularly on initiatives that improve income opportunities among vulnerable segments of society, and also on accelerating the rise of social enterprises. Our goal is to use strategic grantmaking to create large-scale, sustainable impact – across multiple sectors.

Capacity building

Our capacity-building programmes empower organisations to become catalysts for social and economic growth. Whether by strengthening internal resources, or bolstering core skills, we equip nonprofits and social enterprises with the tools they need to learn, improve and scale.

By investing in the long-term health and effectiveness of organisations, we are creating a community of changemakers, working collectively to support equal opportunities within Saudi Arabia.

Policy design and advocacy

We advocate for causes and policies that support the economic empowerment of Saudi citizens, and can power the country's strategic goals. Using an evidence-led approach, we design policy solutions that contribute to building an effective social protection system in the kingdom, and bring a fresh perspective to pressing social issues.

In support of this, we build alliances with government decisionmakers, civil society leaders and the private sector, and strive to mobilise major stakeholders. Through these partnerships, we aim to help shape public agendas and priorities, and ensure the rights of all Saudi residents are represented.

King Khalid Award

The annual King Khalid Award honours people, organisations and initiatives solving tough social challenges with creativity and skill, and empowers others to follow in their footsteps.

The award recognises and celebrates excellence in the fields of corporate sustainability, nonprofit management, and social innovation within Saudi Arabia. Using targeted capacity building, it drives the growth of responsible business practices and social change, enabling candidates to better serve their communities and meet national sustainability goals.

All applicants that enter the award benefit from expert, tailored analysis of their organisational capabilities. This 360 review is paired with learning opportunities and specialist support, helping organisations to innovate, improve and evolve. It is because of this that the award has become the most important accolade honouring people and organisations transforming Saudi society for the better.

Fellowship

The Shaghaf Fellowship equips emerging nonprofit leaders with the skills and tenacity they need to uplift the social sector, and become effective agents of change. Through an intensive development programme, which is designed to give exceptional young Saudis the tools they need for impact, Shaghaf is cultivating a pipeline of future changemakers.

The Shaghaf Fellowship represents a fast-track path to leadership, and an opportunity to take action on issues that make a difference to society. It is operated in partnership with the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.
